## **Signposting**

If you are looking to enter the drug and alcohol treatment system WASP will be able to refer you or put you in touch with the treatment provider. We can provide information that will give you the opportunity to make an informed and educated decision. We have good working relationships with the treatment provider in Wiltshire and some further afield, including the criminal justice system. We are able to offer you both long and short term support.

## **Abstinence Group**

The abstinence group was set up for anybody who has stopped using alcohol & drugs and wants to maintain an abstinent lifestyle.

The only requirement is that you must have been clean and sober for a minimum of two weeks before attending.

## **Addiction Support Line**

Our Service User Reps are able to guide you through the process of accessing treatment, from signposting to referrals. We can help advocate on your behalf if you need information and help around any of your treatment journey. We can support you pre and post treatment, through to long term aftercare. WASP

Originally known as the Wiltshire User Forum, WASP has been operating for a little over 10 years. Not only do we provide the services mentioned, we also work closely with a number of Service Providers across Wiltshire attending provider reviews and commissioning meetings. This enables us to give service users a voice on how treatment is provided, helping Wiltshire provide and improve services that can and do make a difference.

## **Support Groups**

Our support groups have been up & running for over 8 years. We offer a safe place for vulnerable people to address and get help and advice for drug and alcohol addiction issues. The group's facilitators are fully trained and also in recovery. This allows the groups to be peer lead and a relaxed and safe place for people to talk about their problems. Everyone is welcome at any stage of their journey, whether still drinking and/or using, or at any stage of recovery. Over the last few years the groups have helped a great many people by providing an alternative and are complimentary to AA, NA fellowship based programs. The only rule is that you turn up coherent, only having had a medicinal dose, if needed.
